Ascend Services Mobile Work Crew Helping to Mix Things Up at Alpha Baking Inc.

Our relationship with Alpha Baking began in October 2022. We provide mobile work crew services 2 days per week and have offered this opportunity to a total of 20 different clients up to this point. The purpose of the mobile work crew at Alpha is to put the ingredients together for the base of their cinnamon raisin bread. The crew opens boxes of raisins and dumps them into large containers and then adds a specific amount of cinnamon beads to the mixture. The crew also weighs out specific amounts of butter and lard for the mixture.

We appreciate the opportunity to work with Alpha Baking as it gives a different work experience other than a typical manufacturing environment.

Ascend Services' Leaders Attend 2023 DSPN Advocacy Day in Madison

Marissa Fitzgerald, Program Director and Deanna Genske, Executive Director, attended the 2023 DSPN (Disability Services Providor Network) Advocacy Day & Member Engagement in Madison. Family Care providers are behind other employers in their ability to hire staff at competitive wages with full benefits. DSPN members have the greatest disadvantage with Medicaid as their sole payer. Many members turn to philanthropy to fill the disparity between reimbursement and the actual costs of services. This budget presents an opportunity to address systemic problems in Family Care and create an environment that attracts people to careers in long-term care. We were encouraged to meet with the legislators to discuss topics such as: Continuing recent provider rate increases and investments in the Direct Care Workforce Fund, Adequately fund a modernized and sustainable rate system for Family Care providers and The Use of Technology in Long Term Care Settings and Regulatory Relief.
